



SCHOLARSHIP

Novice or Intermediate Dancer - \$250.00

The scholarship will provide assistance to a New Zealand registered dancer who has met the eligibility requirements. The recipient must demonstrate a high level of participation and interest in the art of Highland Dancing which includes competing regularly, sitting examinations etc...

Eligibility:

The applicant must be a 2017 registered Novice or Intermediate dancer. The applicant must reside in New Zealand and be taught by a teacher who is a member of ScotDance New Zealand.

Financial:

The successful applicant will receive \$250.00 which must be used for tuition fees.

Criteria:

Each applicant must submit a completed application form to the President of ScotDance New Zealand by 31 August 2017.

A completed application includes:

- Application form (see page 2)
- A presentation which maybe an essay, a speech (recording of speech to be sent with application), power point, scrapbook with the theme:

"What do you enjoy about Highland Dancing?"

Applications will be assessed by an overseas adjudicator.

Judges decision is final and there will be no correspondence entered into.

Successful applicant must be present at the announcement of the scholarship. The scholarship will be announced at the prize giving of the HDAMRW Championship in October.
