Financial:

The successful applicant will receive \$250.00 which must be used for tuition fees.

Criteria:

Each applicant must submit a completed application form to the Administration Officer of ScotDance New Zealand by 31 May 2018.

A completed application includes:

- A presentation which maybe an essay, a powerpoint presentation, a speech (recording of speech to be sent with application) with the theme:

*What are my goals in Highland Dancing for the next two years?
What do I love about Highland Dancing?*
